A champion of children’s oral health, Lisa Enns has endeavoured to incorporate the message “Baby Teeth Are Important” into every early years project possible, regularly collaborating with physicians, nurses, and allied health staff since she developed the Children’s Oral Health Program at Vancouver Coastal Health—Richmond in 2007. To reduce the community’s high level of early childhood caries, Lisa initiated in-house oral screening clinics for children 0 to 5 years old who are not able to go to private dental offices, and formed many community partnerships that promote prevention or provide free or low-cost dental treatment, always focusing on high-priority populations. Because dental services for adults are not part of public health, Lisa regularly volunteers at free dental clinics for Richmond adults and seniors. Lisa has contributed to evidence-based guidelines in public health, long-term and acute care, and is proud to have welcomed dental hygiene and nursing students into her practice so they can learn to be the voice of children’s oral health in the future.
