Mara is an amazing advocate for oral health not only of her clients but for all members of our community. She was instrumental in the establishment of our community's low cost dental clinic as a founding board member of West Kootenay Community TEETH Clinic Society. As non dental volunteers, we had much to learn about setting up a clinic and operating it. She has worked tirelessly for the past seven years to ensure that we able to increase access to dental care. She made a video that earned the society \$50,000. Mara enlisted support from the local dental professionals to donate \$5,000 for the work of the society. As a board member she helped set up all of our operational policies and communication strategies. Mara has helped the society to establish working relationships with all of the dental supply companies, other dentists, CDAs, and Hygienists in the region to work at the low income clinic on their days off by sharing her passion for oral health for all. We are so very grateful that she shared her expertise and her connections in the dental field to make it possible for us to provide quality dental care for our low income residents. She is our superhero!

From the moment that I arrive for my appointment to the moment that I leave, I feel warmly taken care of. Mara's sunny disposition can brighten anyone's day who has to lie back in a chair, unable to talk and with your mouth wide-open for at least an hour. Always an offer of a heating pad or a kitty cat to sit on my lap. Very bubbly conversation ensues, albeit not from my mouth, and before I know it the appointment is over. Although being an adult and woefully delinquent at flossing my teeth every day one story sticks out the best. It was the time that Mara sang me the song that she created and sang at for kindergarten classes to help make flossing their teeth. There is a line about making sure it's squeaky with that floss in between every tooth. And with that little jingle carefully crafted by herself and relayed to me, I in my late 40s now finally understand the dental floss game. I love to hear that squeaky clean and proud that she has served our community in such a wonderful way.

Dental Hygienist Mara Sand is a key player in my dental health and oral care. I have been seeing her regularly over decades and will very much miss her skill, warmth and optimism. She retires after this year. Mara has been a tireless advocate for community access to dental care. With no small thanks to Mara we now have a low cost dental clinic operating two days a week in Nelson BC!



I was sent a follow up assessment of my teeth and gum health, with recommendations of the actions I should take next to keep things healthy in there. Her mission was clearly to educate me and make me feel comfortable with dental care. Dare I say I even had FUN at my visit...? Spots on my teeth that caused me stress and concern were cleaned away and my teeth looked healthier. I feel grateful to have met her.

Mara started The Dental Access Fund in the West Kootenies many years ago to help those who had no other means of accessing emergency or urgent dental care. Mara was a founding member of the TEETH Clinic in Nelson, BC, a non- profit, low-cost clinic. She has held the rolls of clinician, board member and administrator over the years. Mara volunteers countless hours in her home dental hygiene studio, providing care to people who otherwise would not be able to access dental hygiene services to help them manage their chronic health conditions.
