I also had the privilege to be her course instructor when she completed her Bachelor of Science degree in oral health promotion.

Laura is totally dedicated, and the following account demonstrates that she is a marvellous ambassador for the dental hygiene profession, who models exceptional client care. She is committed to educating and empowering her clients to embrace the "oral health for total health" motto. She is so deserving of this honour because of her remarkable career and numerous, multifaceted contributions to oral health and total health.

Laura has worked in clinical dental hygiene for 40 years, including many years in periodontology. She still works one to two days per week in clinical practice. Her excellent care makes her exceedingly popular with her clients.

Laura works at the Faculty of Dentistry, University of Toronto, where for the last 30 years she has been sharing her expertise with future dentists as a clinical professor. She teaches dentistry students periodontal treatment planning, debridement, and oral health counselling. She was also a faculty member at Durham College and Oxford College in their dental hygiene programs, serving as a clinical instructor and teaching theory, including pharmacology, anatomy, physiology, histology, embryology, and business principles. Laura remains in touch with her former students and generously continues to be a mentor and clinical trainer for dental hygienists.

Laura has also contributed to the dental hygiene profession in other ways. She was a clinical evaluator with the College of Dental Hygienists of Ontario for 18 years, including one year as the chief clinical evaluator. Through her work in sales and education with Micrylium, Laura has contributed to providing effective, safe, non-toxic infection control solutions for the dental, medical, veterinary, farming, and esthetics industries, to keep their clients, workers, animals, and the environment safe.





Laura has also worked in sales and education for Colgate, presenting at conferences and dental hygiene school curriculum programs.
